EVERYDAY DISCIPLES: WHAT DISCIPLES DO

The word "Christian" appears only three times in the New Testament: Acts 11:26, 26:28, and 1 Peter 4:16. Disciple, however, is used over 260 times.

And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch. ~ Acts 11:26b (NKJV)

So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, ² and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets. ³ Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat. ~ Luke 5:1-3 (NKJV)

SIX THINGS A DISCIPLE DOES...

1. DISCIPLES ANSWER THE CALL TO OBEDIENCE

When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." ⁵ But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net." ~ Luke 5:4-5 (NKJV)

Jesus said to the people who believed in him, "You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings. ~ John 8:31 (NLT)

If you love me, obey my commandments. ~ John 14:15 (NLT)

Loving God means keeping his commandments, and his commandments are not burdensome. ~ 1 John 5:3 (NLT)

But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do the things which I say? ~ Luke 6:46

2. DISCIPLES ATTEMPT GREAT THINGS FOR GOD

⁶ And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. ~ Luke 5:6 (NKJV)

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us. ~ Ephesians 3:20 (NKJV)

3. DISCIPLES ADOPT A LIFE OF ADVENTURE

⁷ So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. ~ Luke 5:7 NKJV)

4. DISCIPLES ACKNOWLEDGE THEIR <u>DEPENDENCE</u> UPON THE LORD

⁸ When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" ⁹ For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken; ¹⁰ and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men. ~ Luke 5:8-10 (NKJV)

5. DISCIPLES ACCEPT THEIR <u>ASSIGNMENT</u> FROM GOD

And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men." ~ Luke 5:10b

6. DISCIPLES ABANDON ALL ALTERNATIVES

¹¹ So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him. ~ Luke 5:11 (NKJV)
