Growing as a Disciple

We tend to think about our relationship with Jesus Christ in three ways, two of which are wrong. One of them is correct:

- 1. Me For Christ (Wrong)
- 2. Me And Christ Together (Wrong)
- 3. Christ In Me (Right)
